There is to be an option of two scenic rides on each day Friday, Saturday and Sunday for this National Jampot Rally. The Saturday scenic ride is to cover a distance of 65km to Junee and the shorter ride for those with lesser powered machines will be of 35km to join the others for lunch.

Our Sunday scenic ride to Mangoplah will be over a distance of 83km for the more powerful machines while the considerably briefer ride will cover a much shorter distance of 37km and slightly more suited to the lighter less powerful machines meeting at the same venue for lunch.
